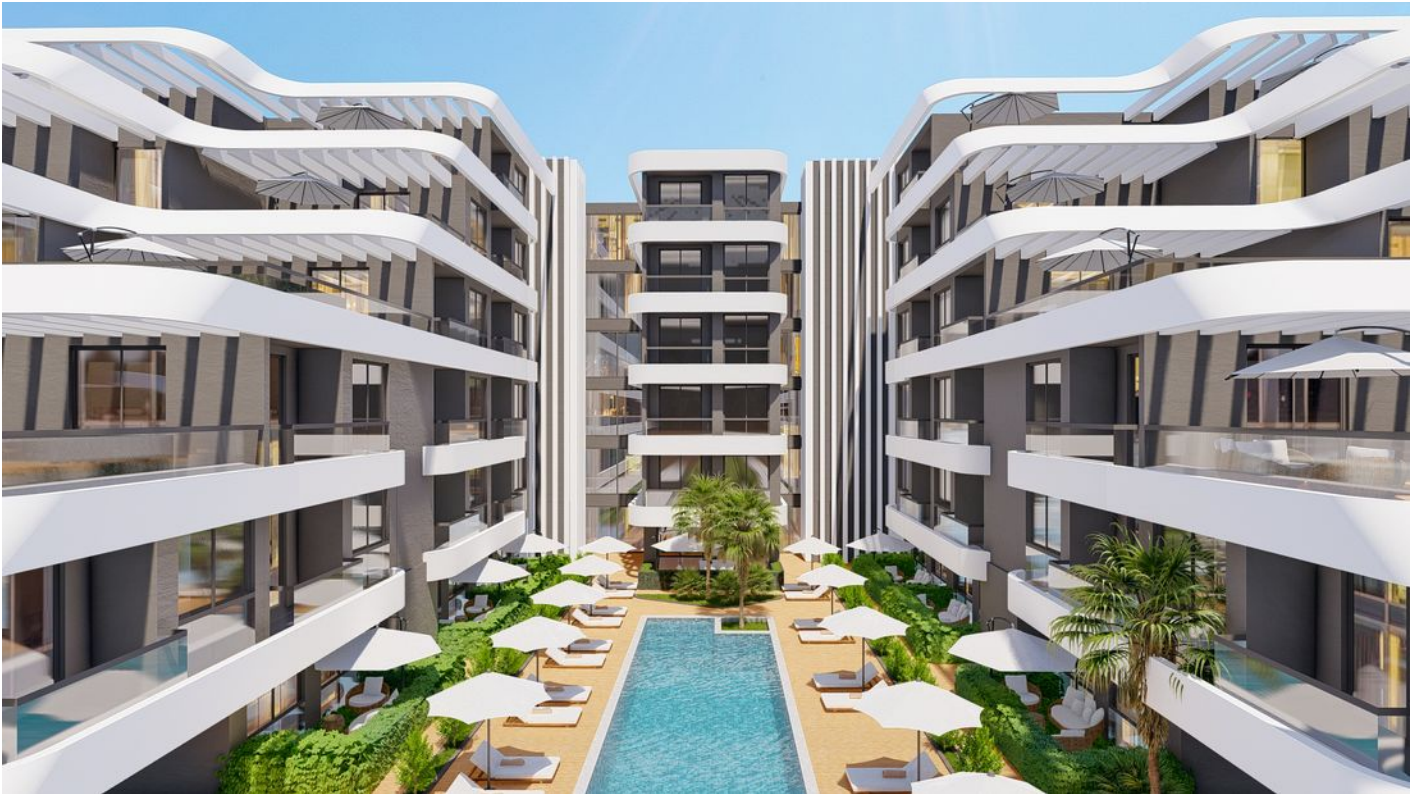

Description

The new project will be built on its own purchased land with a total area of 10.155 m², purchased at the expense of the company's capital.

The collection has a unique architecture designed by architect Adil Okur.

The complex, which will have its own beach in the Lara area, is intended only for residents of Koleksiyon Beach, Antalya.

There will also be a shuttle service to shopping centers.

The payment plan is 35% of the sale price in the contract, and the remaining 65% payment until the end of construction will be paid every 3 months.
