Description

The villa, which is currently being considered for a redevelopment strategy, is located in a gated and well-maintained village with direct access via a 4-lane road to the beach and ocean on the island of Bali.

The location has amenities and security, making it an attractive option for investment and residence.

The villa is a two-story building with stunning views of the ocean and sunset of Bali from the rooftop and second floor.

On a plot of 200 m2 there is a **building of 150 m2 with three rooms**, each of which has its own bathroom. In total, the house has four bathrooms.

IMB construction permit has been obtained and a rental permit (Pandok Wisata) is also available. Electricity and water available (PDMA). The villa was built in 2008.

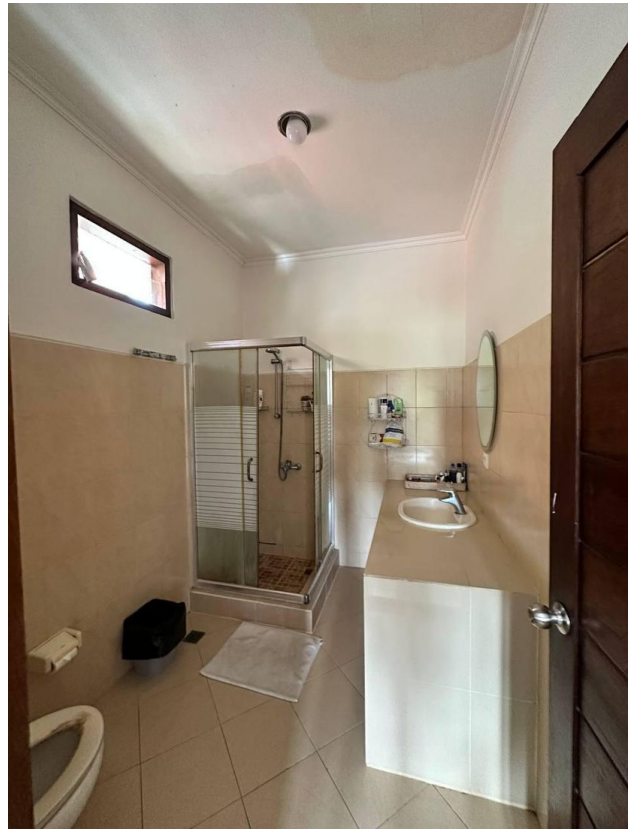
There are two options for purchasing this villa:
