

This unique estate is located within the municipality of Rome, next to Via Cassia, on Via di Santa Maria di Galeria, in the picturesque valley of the Arrone River, on the site of ancient settlements.

The house is built in the traditional style of a Roman farmhouse "Casale" and is surrounded by private grounds that include more than 17 hectares of land.

There is a variety of land here: over 2 hectares of arable land, over 4 hectares of pasture and about 11 hectares of coppice woodland. The territory has its own water source with official permission to use it.

The estate consists of four buildings, built before the 1970s and registered in the cadastre, with a total area of about 500 square meters:

- Two-storey farmhouse of cadastral category A/7, with an area of 373 square meters.
- Utility room for agricultural purposes, category C/2, with an area of 46 square meters.
- Stables, registered as a category C/2 warehouse, measuring 53 square meters.
- Another utility room for agricultural purposes, category C/2 (former chicken coop), with an area of 23 square meters.

All of the above buildings are in need of complete reconstruction.

This Casale farmhouse provides absolute privacy and can be used as a residence for those who want to live close to the capital, but at the same time in peace and surrounded by nature.
