It has a mild climate due to the protection from cold winds by the Taurus Mountains. The place is famous for its natural beauty, sandy beaches and pine groves.

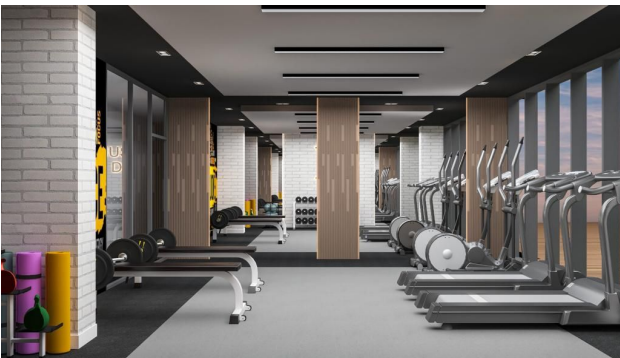
Incekum Beach is known for its gentle entry into the sea, fine sand and lack of big waves, making it ideal for relaxation.

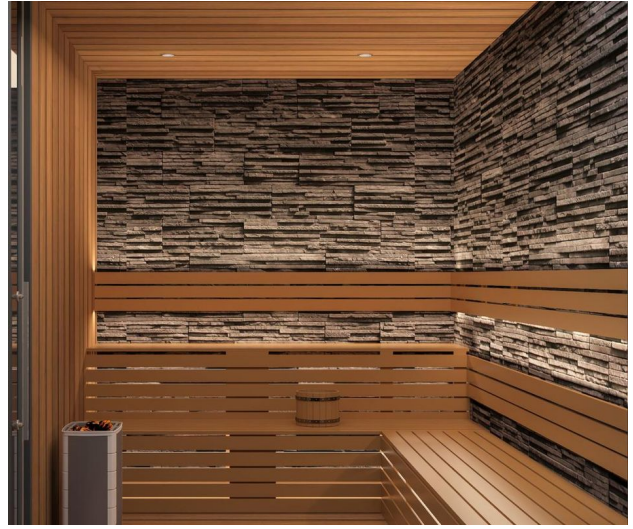
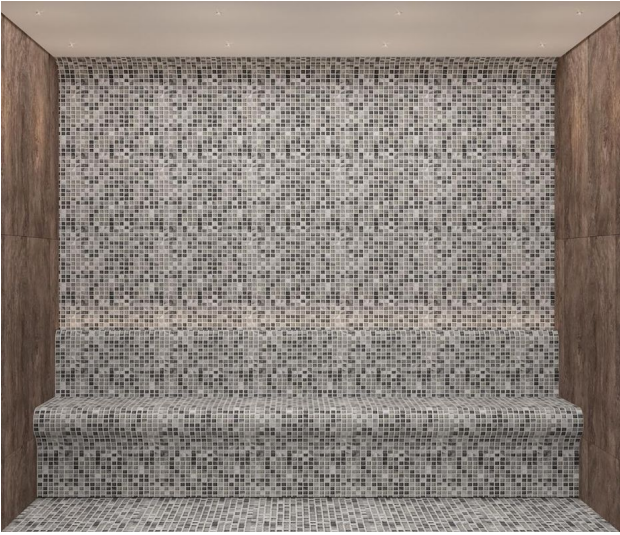
